


# Winterize Home Checklist


**Insulate Your Pipes**  Drain outdoor plumbing of any existing water and insulate to prevent freezing. Check for cracks, and leaks; especially in homes with older plumbing


**Sprinkler System**  Drain Water from the backflow preventer and cover the sprinkler system plumbing with an insulation bag for extra protection

**Furnace Inspection**  Schedule your furnace, heat pump or electric heating system maintenance to ensure your heater is in tip-top shape before it gets too cold.


**Carbon Monoxide Detectors**  Test your smoke and carbon monoxide detectors to ensure proper working order for your safety this winter.


**Propane**  For homes that use propane for your heating systems, check your propane levels to ensure you have plenty to last the winter months.

**Replace Filters**  Replace your HVAC filters to improve the efficiency of your system

**Check your Roof**  Look for any damaged, loose or missing shingles to prevent roof leaks. also check your flashing for signs of rust or damage.

**Attic Insulation & Ventilation** Well insulated and ventilated attics can regulate your homes temperature and reduce the risk of ice dams to form on your roof during the winter. insulation can also keep your home warm in the winter and cool in the summer.

**Gutters**  Clean your gutters, downspouts and any debris on your roof so that water can flow freely.

**Doors**  Replace any faulty caulking or worn weatherstrips to minimize air leaks around your doors and windows.
